

**CHARTER OAK AQUATIC CLUB
PENTATHLON INVITATIONAL MEET**
Held under the sanction of Connecticut Swimming, Inc. and USA
Swimming, Inc. – Sanction #L04-26
July 3th & 4th, 2004

LOCATION: Odessa Terry Pool, Hockanum Park, High Street, East Hartford. Emergency #(860) 291-7442. 8-lane, 50 meter pool with a depth of 10+ feet at the blocks. Colorado Timing System with touch pads will be used. Seating is outside the fence. Bring your own chairs. This facility is elderly/disables accessible. Spectator area is grass.

INVITATION: Open to all USA Swimming registered swimmers. Out-of-state teams should supply a team roster signed by their LSC registration chair. In the event of oversubscription, they will be based on date of entry receipt with check (last entries received will be cut first).

MEET SCHEDULE: Saturday AM – 10 & unders; 13/14 7:30 warm-up
8:30 start
Sunday AM – 11/12; 15 & overs 7:30 warm-up
8:30 start

ENTRIES: In order to be included in Pentathlon scoring, a swimmer must compete in the events offered in their age group. A swimmer may enter and swim less events for time, but will not be included in the scoring for awards. The freestyle event is defined as a stroke other than butterfly, breast or back. There are no cut off times for this event. Entries must be submitted in long course meter times. “NO TIMES” for an event will not be accepted. Swimmers must be registered members of USA Swimming, please make sure to include their up-to-date registration numbers with the entry. Age group will be determined by age as of July 3, 2004. Swimmers are limited to four (4) individual events per day – 10 & unders; 11 & overs to five (5) individual events per day

USA Swimming Rules will govern this meet. The meet referee reserves the right to make any adjustments to the provisions of the meet announcement deemed necessary to ensure the fair and efficient running of the meet.

Connecticut Swimming warm-up procedures will be used. The Meet Manager reserves the right to assign general warm-up by team rather than age or sex, if the size of the entry and considerations of safety so require. The Meet Manager also reserves the right to combine sessions, cancel relays, and/or adjust start times, subject to the approval of CSI Program Operations.

AWARDS: Trophies to top 12 cumulative scorers in each age group. Total of 96 individual trophies.

ENTRY DUE DATE: Entries are accepted on a first come first serve basis. CT teams that enter by June 23, 2004 will be entered first. Final deadline for entries will be June 29, 2004. Formal team entry date is determined by the date of entry hard copy and entry fee receipt by host team. If entries are sent via overnight mail, please waive the "signature required".

All teams are encourage to send their entry on disk using the LSA Swim Meet/Swim Team program or Hytek in USA Standard Data Interchange Format (SDIF). A disk must accompany all computer-generated entries. If you choose to send your entry via email you must still mail a paper printout of the entry (mandatory) with your check for your entry to be considered valid.

Unattached swimmers must be clearly indicated in red alongside the swimmer's name. Information contained on the original computer generated paper copy will be considered the official document of entry and supersedes any information contained on electronic disk or file with respect to resolution of errors/discrepancies. Meet results will be provided on disk to any team submitting its entries on disk. Teams with 10 or more swimmers will be assessed \$1 per swimmer if the entry is submitted on paper, without a disk. Entry chairpersons are encourage to provide an e-mail address along with their phone number.

WORK ASSIGNMENTS: Teams will be required to supply timers in proportion to the size of their entry. Please note that timers are required for the whole session. Qualified officials interested in working at the meet

are encouraged to contact the Meet Referee or indicate their interest by attachments to the meet entry form.

SCRATCHES: Coaches will receive scratch sheets at the beginning of the sessions. Scratch sheets must be returned within 20 minutes after the start of warm-ups. Connecticut Swimming scratch procedures will be followed and enforced (i.e., swimmers who are not scratched and fail to compete in an event will be scratched from their next individual event).

ALL COACHES ON DECK MUST BE PREPARED TO SHOW CURRENT COACHING CREDENTIALS.
