SANCTION: This meet will be governed by USA Swimming rules and sanctioned by Connecticut Swimming, Inc.

Connecticut warm-up guidelines and scratch procedures will be observed.

DATE: **Saturday, February 22, 2003**

LOCATION: Jack Suydam Natatorium, Central CT State University

FACILITIES: 6-lane, 25 yard pool with a depth of 12 feet at the blocks. There is ample deck space for swimmers and spectator seating for 600.

SCHEDULE: The meet has been divided into two sessions.

GIRLS

Morning Session

8:00 Warm-ups

9:00 Start

BOYS

Afternoon Session

1:30 Warm-ups

2:30 Start

Absolutely no diving will be allowed during warm-up except during one way sprints, which must be supervised by the respective coaches. Connecticut Swimming warm-up procedures will be used. They will be posted at the pool and included in the coaches' packets.

EVENTS: All events will be timed finals. Swimmers may enter four (4) individual events, in addition to relays. Relays will be cut prior to swimmers being limited to 3 events. **Circle 4th events** on the entry sheet. Please submit swimmers yard times to insure proper seeding. **For any unattached swimmers clearly mark UN in RED** alongside the swimmer's name on the entry sheet.

NO RECALL: No recall procedure will be in effect (102.14.4H)

FAILURE TO COMPETE: In all events, after the heats have been seeded, any swimmer who fails to compete in an individual event in which he has been entered and from which he has not been scratched shall be barred from competing in his next individual event.

EXCEPTIONS TO FAILURE TO COMPETE: No penalty shall apply for failure to compete if:

The referee is notified in the event of injury or illness and accepts the proof thereof.

If it is determined by the referee that the failure to compete is caused by

circumstances beyond the control of the swimmer.

ELIGIBILITY:

All swimmers must be 2003 CSI registered. Age is determined on the day of the meet. Coaches must be 2003 registered and must show valid coaches card.

UNDER-SUBSCRIPTION:

If either session times out to two hours or less, girls and boys will be combined together in one four hour session. Team contacts will be notified of the change by Monday, February 17, 2003.

The host team also reserves the right to combine heats in order to provide appropriate competition.

AWARDS:

CSI championship awards will be provided for 1-6 places in each individual event and 1-3 places for each relay.

TIMERS:

Teams will be asked to supply timers based on the size of their total team entry. Assignments will be posted and must filled for the duration of each session.

ENTRIES:

All entries must be submitted on CT meet entry forms or a computer generated facsimile. In case of dispute, the entry form will be regarded as the official document of entry.

Teams are encouraged to submit their entries on disk using the LSA format or other SDIF compatible software. Entries must include a hard copy along with the disk. Include the club name, the name and phone number of a club contact person, and the address where results are to be sent. For legibility reasons, the entry must be the original. **Manual Entry Fee:** For teams submitting paper entries only (no computer disk) with greater than five swimmers, a \$1 charge will be added for each additional swimmer over five.

**HANDICAPPED/
ELDERLY ACCESSABILITY:**

Handicapped parking and ramped access to the pool are located o at the main lobby entrance of the facility. An area has been set aside on the pool deck for limited handicapped seating. Access to this area can be obtained through the men/women locker rooms. Marshals will be located at the pool deck entrances of the locker rooms to assist you. Handicapped bathrooms are available in both the men and women locker rooms. In order that we may better prepare to assist individuals with special needs, we ask that you contact the Meet Manager, Dan Garaffa at (860) 646-4377, prior to the meet.

DIRECTIONS: From the EAST: Take I-84 West to Exit 39A to Rt. 9 South. Take Exit 29 off of Rt. 9 to Ella Grasso Boulevard and take a right turn to the University. Alternate Route: Take I-84 eAst to Exit 40, (Corbins Corner), take a left turn at end of exit ramp, and a right turn at the next traffic light onto Rt. 71 South. Follow Rt. 71 South 3 miles to the University.

From the WEST: Take I-84 East to Exit 39A, to Rt. 9 South. Take Exit 29 off of Rt. 9 South to Ella Grasso Boulevard and take a right turn to the University. Alternate Route: Take I-84 East to Exit 5, Rt. 72 East (New Britain Exit). Follow Rt. 72 East to Rt. 9 North and take Exit 29 to Cedar Street Rt. 175). At the traffic light at the end of the ramp, take a left turn to the second traffic light, and take a right turn onto Paul Manafort Drive to the University.

From the SOUTH: (New York area) Take I-95 North to I-91 North to Exit 22 North to Rt. 9 North. Follow Rt. 9 to Exit 29, Cedar Street (Rt. 175). At the traffic light at the end of the ramp, take a left turn to the second traffic light, and take a right turn onto Paul Manafort Drive to the University.

From the SOUTH: (Rhode Island area) Take I-95 South to Rt. 9 (Old Saybrook). Take Rt. 9 North to Exit 29, Cedar Street (Rt. 175). At the traffic light at the end of the ramp, take a left turn to the second traffic light, and take a right turn onto Paul Manafort Drive to the University.

From the NORTH: Take I-91 South to I-84 West to Exit 39A, to Rt. 9 South. Take Exit 29 off Rt. 9 South to Ella Grasso Boulevard and take a right turn to the University. Alternate Route: Take I-91 South to I-84 West to Exit 40 (Corbins Corner), take a left turn at the end of the exit ramp, and a right turn at the next traffic light onto Rt. 71 South, 3 miles to the University.
